

# Growth of Georgia ...

*since 1900*

The state of **Georgia** has grown dramatically since 1900. In the 1900 census, **Georgia's** population was at (#1) 2,216,331 people. **Georgia's** growth was slow during the first 50 years of the 1900's, as the 1950 census documented the state population to be (#2) at 3,444,578 people.

By the 1990 census, **Georgia's** population had doubled to (#3) 6,478,216 people since the 1950 census. The 2000 census saw another jump in **Georgia's** population, (#4) 8,186,453 people. However, there wasn't much of an increase in a July 2004 documentation of **Georgia's** population which was at (#5) 8,829,383 people. The 2010 census marked **Georgia's** population at (#6) 9,687,653 people.

Finally, a 2013 documentation of **Georgia's** population showed that (#7) 9,992,167 people were living in **Georgia**.
